



BE AN INFORMED VOTER BEFORE THE ELECTION

WHO CAN VOTE?

- You must be a citizen of the United States, a resident of Missouri, and 18 years old by election day
- You must not be imprisoned, cannot be on probation or parole following conviction of a felony, and cannot have been convicted of a felony or misdemeanor related to elections

WHERE DO I GO TO VOTE?

- You must be registered to vote in the jurisdiction where you live
- You can find information on your polling place on the Voter Identification Card you receive in the mail prior to the election

KNOW YOUR RIGHTS ON ELECTION DAY

On election day, polling places are open from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m.

WHAT ARE ACCEPTED FORMS OF ID AT THE POLLS?

- Voter Identification Card
- Military ID
- College, university, vocational or technical school ID from an institution of higher learning in Missouri
- A current utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, or government check that shows your name and current address
- Driver's license or state identification card

A PHOTO ID IS NOT REQUIRED TO VOTE IN THE STATE OF MISSOURI.

WHAT ARE MY RIGHTS AT THE POLLING PLACE?

- You have the right to assistance in the voting booth
- You have the right to accessible voting
- You have the right to a private ballot
- You have the right to vote your conscience
- You have the right to vote if you are in line when polls close at 7 p.m.

AT YOUR POLLING PLACE, NO ONE MAY:

- Intimidate you or interfere with the voting process
- Attempt to influence your vote within 25 feet of the entrance

Poll workers are not allowed to discuss specifics of the election
