Re: Sunshine Request

This letter is a request under the Missouri Sunshine Law. Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 610 of the Missouri Revised Statutes, we request that you provide copies of:

- 1. All records your office provided to the Presidential Advisory Commission on Election Integrity ("Commission") in response to the portion of the June 28, 2017 letter your office received from Vice Chair Kris Kobach soliciting "your views and recommendations," including your responses to the seven questions posed in the June 28, 2017 letter, and any supporting records;
- 2. All records containing, referring to, supporting, or related to your "views and recommendations" to the Commission.
- 3. All communications and documents related to your response to the June 28, 2017 letter; and
- 4. All communications between your office and the Commission or any of its members since January 1, 2017.

We emphasize that, unlike Mr. Kobach, we <u>do not</u> request any voter roll data. Voters have a reasonable expectation that their voting data will remain secure. Like the Commission, we do not have precautions in place to protect the security of such data.

If any part of this request is denied, please send a letter listing the specific exemptions upon which you rely for each denial and provide the contact information for the official to whom we may appeal. Mo. Rev. Stat. § 610.023.4. This request must "be acted upon as soon as possible, but in no event later than the end of the third business day following the date the request is received." Mo. Rev. Stat. § 610.023.3.

Because this records request is being submitted in the public interest and "is likely to contribute significantly to public understanding of the operation or activities" of your office, we ask that you waive any fees or charge a substantially reduced fee pursuant to Mo. Rev. Stat. § 610.026.1(1). However, should you decline to waive or reduce fees, proceed without further approval if the cost does not exceed \$50.00, and send a detailed invoice with the records. If the cost will exceed \$50.00, please inform us of the cost in advance.
