CONSENT JUDGMENT

This matter coming before the Court on the Parties Joint Motion for Approval of their Consent Judgment, and on the Court being fully advised in the premises, the Court hereby enters the following Order:

- 1. The City of St. Ann, Missouri, has previously enacted an Ordinance restricting the size of political signs and the duration during which political signs might be displayed in § 525.090 of the St. Ann Code.
- 2. The City is aware that the validity of such provisions have been called into doubt pursuant to decisions such as *Neighborhood Enterprises v. City of St. Louis*, 644 F.3d 728 (8th Cir. 2011).
- 3. The City is enjoined from enforcing or threatening to enforce the provisions of its existing sign code relative to political signs. The City has agreed to pay Plaintiff One Dollar (\$1.00) in nominal damages.
 - 4. Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Injunction [ECF No. 2] is denied as moot.
- This Consent Judgment fully and finally resolves all claims of Plaintiff against the
 City relative to the placement of political signs.

- 6. The parties shall bear their own attorneys' fees and costs.
- 7. This Court retains jurisdiction to enforce this Consent Judgment.
