Statement of Offense: (Give essential facts)

Sergeant Anthony Boone was assigned supervision over five undercover detectives during the World Series Scalping Detail between October 24 - 27, 2006. Two of the detectives assigned to Sergeant Boone gave a total of 12 World Series Tickets, which had been seized as evidence, to family members for attendance to World Series Games.

The investigation further revealed that the undercover detectives assigned to Sergeant Boone, during the Detail, did not complete criminal history inquiries and warrant/"wanted" inquiries in 4 out of 9 arrests, as mandated by Special Order 94-S-7.

Through this investigation, it was additionally learned that on 16 occasions between January - August 2006, Sgt. Boone authorized currency to remain in an office safe well beyond the time, mandated by Special Order 2000-S-3, to be relinquished to the Asset Forfeiture Division.

Sergeant Anthony Boone is in violation of Police Manual Rule 4, Bureau of Investigation, subsection 4.031, Responsibilities of Section Supervisors, which reads in applicable part, "Each section supervisor shall be responsible...for the general appearance, good order and discipline, and proper attention to duties of the personnel under his supervision..."

Recommended Disciplinary Punishment:

It is recommended Sergeant Anthony Boone receive twenty-two (22) days of Disciplinary Suspension.

I, Sergeant Anthony Boone, above referred to, state that I am fully informed as to the nature of a complaint against me, involving my violation of Police Department Rules, and detailed in reports bearing Internal Affairs File No. 07/068; and that I am advised of the recommendations to be made to the Board of Police Commissioners for disciplinary punishment to be imposed upon me; and that further, I fully realize that I have the right, as a police officer, to demand and have a hearing and trial of this complaint before said Board; but, with the Board's approval wish to WAIVE or give up my right to a hearing and trial and accept immediately said punishment, realizing that such punishment and my acceptance of same is subject to the concurrence and approval by the Board which can order a hearing be held and that I stand trial.
