Michael Deeba, then Commander of the Vice/Narcotics Division, was assigned to supervise the World Series Scalping Detail from October 24 - 27, 2006. Three sergeants and eighteen detectives, assigned to the Vice/Narcotics Division, were assigned to the detail. The detectives made arrests and created forty-four police reports, involving the seizure if ninety-eight World Series Tickets, during this detail. It was alleged that these detectives permitted family members and friends to utilize seized tickets to enter several World Series Games. The investigation into this allegation showed other violations existed, including errors in the reports, wanted checks not being conducted on the arrested subjects and other evidence handling errors. It is alleged that Lt. Michael Deeba is in violation of Police Manual Rule 4, Bureau of Investigation, subsection 4.021, which reads, "Each division commander, in consultation with each section supervisor under his command, shall establish such operating rules and procedures as he believes are required for the efficient operation of his section...Such operating rules shall be prepared in writing...and shall be on file in the office of the division commander..." RECOMMENDED DESCIPLINARY PUNISHMENT: Lieutenant Deeba is to receive five (5) days of Disciplinary Leave. Captain Level Leyshoch 1920 Capt. Gerald Leyshock, Commander, District Four SUBMITTED BY: Lt. Michael Deeba , above referred to, state that I am fully informed as to the nature of a complaint against me, involving a violation of Police Department rules, detailed in Internal Affairs File ; that I am advised of the recommendations for disciplinary punishment to be imposed upon me; that, as applicable, I realize I have the right to refer this matter; 1) for a full investigation and review by the Chief of Police, or, 2) for disposition by a Summary Hearing Board; that I am not being coerced into signing this consent; and that I have not been promised a lesser penalty for signing. Being fully aware of these options, I wish to: Waive my rights as indicated above and accept the recommended punishment Have these charges decided by a Summary Hearing Board (commissioned) Have these charges fully investigated and reviewed by the Chief of Police (civilian) If the recommended discipline is less than a suspension or if accepting discipline of less than 16 days suspension, and the employee wishes to make a statement, attach statement and initial here.
