Consent Judgment

The parties having stipulated and consented to the relief set forth below and the entry of this Consent Judgment,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendant, Board of Election Commissioners for the City of St. Louis, Missouri, its officers, employees, or agents, and those acting on its behalf or in concert with it, are enjoined from enforcing or manifesting any intent to enforce any rule, policy, or practice of seizing, in the absence of a court order directing such seizure by Defendant, of any campaign materials.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order shall not prevent Defendant from removing election signs or literature within twenty-five feet of a polling place in accordance with

Missouri Revised Statutes § 115.637(18).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant, its officers, employees, or agents, and those acting on its behalf or in concert with it, are enjoined from reenacting the policy of October 27, 2014, which regulates the content of campaign literature and authorizes seizure of non-compliant materials.
