ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION

Pending is Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Injunction. (Doc. 5.) Defendant's response, (Doc. 19), represents that the parties have agreed to the terms of a Preliminary Injunction. Based on the parties' agreement, the Motion for Preliminary Injunction is **GRANTED.**

The parties have agreed that Defendant will be preliminarily enjoined from enforcing certain language in Springfield Ordinance § 78-222(b)(1). The Court will honor and effectuate the parties' agreement and directs that while this Preliminary Injunction is in effect § 78-222(b)(1) effectively reads as follows: "Indecent exposure or conduct' shall include the exposure of one's genitals, buttocks, vulva, pubic hair, or pubic area for the purpose of sexual arousal or gratification or which is likely to cause affront or alarm."

At the parties' request, all proceedings in this case will be stayed for sixty days. The parties shall file a Joint Status Report on or before March 23, 2016; at that time the Court will determine whether the parties should submit a Joint Proposed Scheduling Order
