ORDER

The Court held a hearing on February 15, 2013, regarding Plaintiffs' motion for a temporary restraining order [Doc. # 138]. During this hearing, Plaintiffs argued that Defendants' drug-testing policy was unconstitutional as applied to the students tested in September 2011 and submitted supplemental briefing on this issue, *see* [Doc. # 143]. The Court now finds that a temporary restraining order should issue.

Accordingly, Plaintiffs' motion for a temporary restraining order [Doc. # 138] is GRANTED, subject to the same bond previously filed in response to Plaintiffs' motion for a temporary restraining order. *See* [Doc. # 15].

It is further ORDERED that Defendants, their successors, officers, agents, servants, employees, attorneys, and all persons acting in concert with them, or in connection with them, are prohibited from conducting any further testing or reporting the results of any testing of the urine specimens collected in September 2011, pursuant to the

challenged drug-testing policy until the expiration of this Order, *see* Fed. R. Civ. P. 65(b), or further order of this Court.
